

PRESENTACIÓN FINAL ESPAÑOL 4C PROYECTO DE INVESTIGACIONES

FINAL PRODUCT:

- Present a topic of interest that you researched that relates to Spanish class. (see list of topics)
- Speak for 6-9 minutes about your topic.
- The goal of this presentation is to show and practice your ability in presenting information to your peers in a way that can be understood by them.
- Use 3-4 real-life reputable sources to guide your research.

PRESENTACIONES 6,7,8,9 DE JUNIO

La presentación

- At least 6 slides. slides should have minimal text and should include images/ graphs. Audio/video can be used to aid your presentation. Neither can be more than 1 minute in length.
- You may ask the audience to participate to keep them engaged, but it doesn't count towards the time.
- Be sure to use grammar and vocabulary that can be understood by your peers. If you didn't understand it when you first read it, your peers probably won't either. Use more basic language to explain complicated concepts.
- You may use limited notes to guide you, but if it turns into a script you will lose points.
- Use good presentation skills: project your voice, maintain eye contact, talk to students and teacher, have good pacing, be animated

Actual presentation (slides)

- **Title slide**- name, theme
- **Introducción**- introduce your theme and question you researched. its recommended to ask a question that can involve the audience and get people interested.
- **Explain your findings** in 3-4 slides making reference to your sources and what the implicate for your question. Include relevant information only. Be sure that these slides use minimal text. You should be speaking about something you have researched and are familiar with. this section can include graphics and images as well.
- **Conclusion**- answer important points of your findings, reflect on what was most interesting to you about the research, additional questions you have that aren't answered in your research. anything else you want to include, be prepared to answer any clarifying questions.
