

# SERVICE AND LEARNING TRIP TO NICARAGUA



**WHEN:** July 24 – August 2, 2018

**WHO:** Open to anyone 15+, willing to work, have fun, and learn

**WHAT WILL WE DO?** With a focus on solidarity, contribution and health, we will work alongside a deserving family and professional contractors to build a house and latrine. We will build an ecofriendly stove, visit a public health clinic, a school for special needs children, or do other service projects. We will also learn about Nicaraguan history, the indigenous people of the area, and may go to a beach, climb a volcano, explore Leon, or learn about local businesses such as a bee farm, a pottery studio or an organic farm.

**WHO WITH?** Jenny deBeer Charno has her Master's Degree in Community Health and is happy to be partnering with FNE International. FNE International is a 501(c)3 organization that partners with communities in developing nations to identify opportunities to advance housing, health and education.

**HOW MUCH?** The trip costs \$600 plus airfare, (between \$500 - \$750 round trip.) Each participant is also required to fundraise a minimum of \$300. As a nonprofit organization, FNEI generates all of its project capital from the generosity of donors and through various fundraising methods. These funds pay for the projects we are engaged with. Perhaps the biggest single responsibility of a Nicaragua trip participant and the collective group as a whole is meeting and exceeding fundraising goals.
